PROCEDURAL ORDER RE: SCHEDULE

On September 7, 2017, Georgia Mountain Community Wind, LLC (“GMCW”), in accordance with the requirements of the Public Utility Commission’s Order of August 24, 2017, filed a proposed schedule for the balance of this proceeding. No other party filed a proposed schedule.

On September 11, 2017, I issued an Order directing the non-respondent parties to this matter, the Vermont Department of Public Service (“Department”) and Scott and Melodie McLane (the “McLanes”) to file proposed schedules no later than close of business on September 18, 2017.

On September 18, 2017, the Department filed a letter expressing its support for GMCW’s proposed schedule.

The McLanes did not file a proposed schedule or comments on GMCW’s proposal.

Accordingly, the following schedule is hereby adopted for this proceeding:

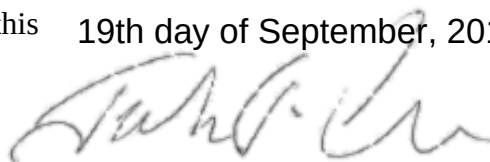
Date	Event
September 29, 2017	Discovery served on GMCW
October 16, 2017	GMCW responds to discovery
October 30, 2017	Parties file testimony/exhibits and/or recommendations regarding whether turbine operations during icing conditions on January 3, 2017 constituted a violation of the CPG, and if so, what penalty (if any) should be imposed
November 20, 2017	Parties file rebuttal testimony/exhibits and/or rebuttal recommendations
November 27, 2017	Parties file requests, if any, for an evidentiary hearing

TBD	Evidentiary hearing, if required
Two weeks after evidentiary hearing	Post-hearing briefs
One week after briefs	Post-hearing reply briefs
TBD	Proposal for decision
TBD	Commission final order

In lieu of discovery in response to the filings due on October 30 and November 20, 2017, the parties shall concurrently file all documents that they were reviewed, relied upon, or generated by a witness in preparing their prefiled testimony or exhibits.

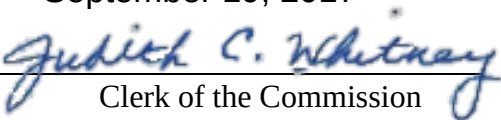
