PROCEDURAL ORDER

On January 23, 2018, the Vermont Department of Public Service (“Department”) filed a motion for admission *pro hac vice* of attorney Jake Clark, Esq., to appear in this proceeding.

On January 26, 2018, the Department submitted a request to withdraw the appearance of Jeanne Elias, Esq., as counsel for the Department in this proceeding

The motion for admission of Mr. Clark *pro hac vice* states that Mr. Clark is a member in good standing of the bar of the District of Columbia and is awaiting approval for admission to the Vermont bar. The motion further states that James Porter, Director of Public Advocacy for the Department, will serve as co-counsel of record in this case with Mr. Clark.

No responses or objections to the motion were filed.

In regard to Ms. Elias’s withdrawal, pursuant to Commission Rule 2.201(D), “An attorney who has appeared on behalf of a party may withdraw only upon permission of the Commission.” The Department has indicated that Jake Clark, Esq., and James Porter, Esq., will appear on behalf of the Department in this matter. As a result, no prejudice will accrue to any party by attorney Elias’s withdrawal. Accordingly, I hereby grant attorney Elias’s request to withdraw her appearance on behalf of the Department in this docket.

Additionally, the motion of the Department for admission *pro hac vice* of Jake Clark, Esq., is hereby granted pursuant to Commission Rule 2.201(C).

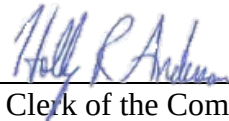
