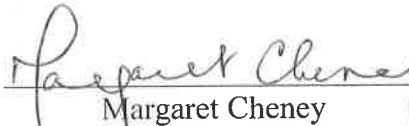
ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW
