Dear Ms. Whitney:

The Public Utility Commission ("Commission") previously directed the Department of Public Service ("Department") to conduct a fall and a spring sound monitoring campaign each lasting two to five weeks, and to submit reports within six weeks of the monitoring period.¹ The second campaign—the spring monitoring campaign—occurred from May 8 through June 12, 2019. On July 25, 2019, the Department filed a letter stating that due to anomalies with the underlying data, the spring report was delayed and would be filed no later than August 16, 2019.

The Department is filing the attached report for the spring 2019 sound monitoring campaign. The data anomalies are discussed in Section 3.3.5. Per a conversation with Commission staff on July 22, 2019, the Department is submitting the original and four copies.
