Amended Petition of Deerfield Wind, LLC, for a certificate of public good authorizing it to construct and operate a 15-turbine, 30 MW wind generation facility, and associated transmission and interconnection facilities, on approximately 80 acres in the Green Mountain National Forest, located in Searsburg and Readsboro, Vermont, with 7 turbines to be placed on the east side of Route 8 on the same ridgeline as the existing GMP Searsburg wind facility (Eastern Project Area), and 8 turbines along the ridgeline to the west of Route 8 in the northwesterly orientation (Western Project Area)

SCHEDULING ORDER

This case pertains to the amended certificate of public good (“Amended CPG”) issued by the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) to Deerfield Wind, LLC (“Deerfield”) for construction and operation of a 30 MW wind electric generation facility located in Searsburg and Readsboro, Vermont (the “Project”).

On October 1, 2019, the Commission held a status conference in this matter.

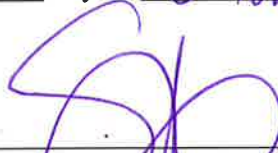
On October 15, 2019, Deerfield submitted a joint scheduling proposal agreed to by all parties, which I adopt.

November 1, 2019	Deadline for Deerfield and DPS to provide responses to the Commission’s Order of 4/25/19.
November 15, 2019	Deadline for parties’ comments on Spring Sound Report and any additional comments on Mr. Shea’s request for OINR testing.
December 13, 2019	Deadline for parties’ responses to the other parties’ filings on Spring Sound Report and Mr. Shea’s request for OINR testing.

Pursuant to 30 V.S.A. §§ 20 and 21, the Commission will allocate court reporter costs incurred during this proceeding to Deerfield.
