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**DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION TO
THE COMMENT DEADLINE**

On December 10, 2019, Georgia Mountain Community Wind, LLC (GMCW) filed a request for the Public Utility Commission (Commission) to approve GMCW's second revised winter operating protocol (2nd Revised WOP). On December 16, 2019, the Commission issued an order requesting comments on the 2nd Revised WOP by January 6, 2020.

The Department of Public Service (Department) moves for a two-week extension to the comment deadline, in which case comments would be due January 20, 2020. The Department has reviewed GMCW's 2nd Revised WOP, but would like additional time to confer with the parties. The Department contacted the parties. GMCW does not oppose the extension. The Department has not yet heard back from the McLanes. The Department notes that Scott and Melodie McLane requested that the comment deadline be set "well after the holiday season" to give them ample time to review GMCW's proposal.
