ORDER RE DEADLINE FOR COMMENTS

On December 10, 2019, Georgia Mountain Community Wind, LLC (“GMCW”) filed proposed revisions to its approved winter operating protocol that GMCW contends will make more accurate determinations on when to shut down its turbines under icing conditions.

On December 16, 2019, Scott and Melodie McLane filed a request that the deadline for filing comments in response to GMCW’s December 10 filing be set well after the holidays so that they can take the time needed to learn about the revisions to the approved protocol that GMCW is proposing.

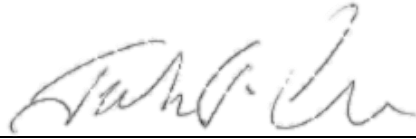
On December 16, 2019, I issued an order establishing January 6, 2020, as the deadline for filing comments on the proposed revisions to the protocol.

On December 23, 2019, the Vermont Department of Public Service (“Department”) filed a motion requesting that the deadline for comments be extended until January 20, 2020. The Department represents that GMCW is not opposed to the extension request. The Department further represents that it has not been able to discuss the request with the McLanes but notes that the McLanes’ December 16 filing asked for a deadline that was well after the holidays.

Based on the representations in the Department’s motion, its request is granted. Comments on GMCW’s December 10, 2019, proposed revisions to its winter operating protocol are due no later than the close of business on January 20, 2020.

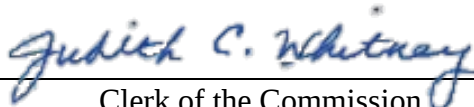
