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**DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE SECOND MOTION FOR AN
EXTENSION OF COMMENT DEADLINE**

On December 10, 2019, Georgia Mountain Community Wind, LLC (GMCW) filed a request for the Public Utility Commission (Commission) to approve GMCW's second revised winter operating protocol (2nd Revised WOP). On December 16, 2019, the Commission issued an order requesting comments on the 2nd Revised WOP by January 6, 2020. On December 23, 2019, the Department of Public Service (Department) moved to extend the comment deadline to January 20, 2020, to allow time for the parties to confer. The Commission granted this motion on December 24, 2019.

The Department now moves to extend the comment deadline by an additional three weeks, to Monday, February 10, 2020. The parties are continuing to discuss implementation of the 2nd Revised WOP. The Department is authorized to represent that the parties (GMCW and Scott and Melodie McLane) support this request.
