**SECOND ORDER RE DEADLINE FOR COMMENTS**

On December 10, 2019, Georgia Mountain Community Wind, LLC (“GMCW”) filed proposed revisions to its approved winter operating protocol that GMCW contends will make more accurate determinations on when to shut down its turbines under icing conditions.

The deadline for filing comments on GMCW’s proposed revisions is currently January 20, 2020.

On January 14, 2020, the Vermont Department of Public Service (“Department”) filed a motion requesting that the deadline for comments be extended until February 10, 2020. The Department represents that the other parties to this matter support its request.

Based on the representations in the Department’s motion, its request is granted. Comments on GMCW’s December 10, 2019, proposed revisions to its winter operating protocol are due no later than the close of business on February 10, 2020.
