**GEORGIA MOUNTAIN COMMUNITY WIND, LLC'S
MOTION TO CHANGE SCHEDULE**

On December 10, 2019, Georgia Mountain Community Wind, LLC (“GMCW”) filed a request for the Public Utility Commission (the “Commission”) to approve a second revised Winter Operating Protocol (“2nd Revised WOP”). On December 16, 2019, the Commission issued an order requesting comments on the 2nd Revised WOP by January 6, 2020, and then later extended the comment deadline to January 20th at the request of the Department of Public Service (the “Department” or “DPS”) in order to allow time for the parties to confer before submitting comments. On January 14, 2020, the Department moved for a second extension to allow the parties to continue discussing the implementation of the 2nd Revised WOP, which the Commission granted, extending the deadline to February 10, 2020.

Georgia Mountain Community Wind now moves to extend the comment deadline by an additional three weeks, to March 2, 2020. The parties have continued discussions on implementing GMCW’s proposed changes to the revised WOP, including the potential for running a trial test of the new software before determining whether the 2nd Revised WOP should be approved.

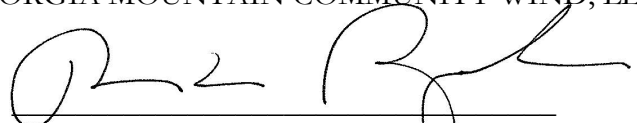
GMCW requests this additional extension of time so that it may work with Goldwind to prepare the technical parameters for the trial period, and then give the other parties (the Department and Scott and Melodie McLane) the opportunity to review those trial parameters before submitting comments to the Commission.

GMCW is authorized to represent that the parties (the Department and Scott and Melodie McLane) support this request.
