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**DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE THIRD MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF
COMMENT DEADLINE**

On December 10, 2019, Georgia Mountain Community Wind, LLC (GMCW) filed a request for the Public Utility Commission (Commission) to approve GMCW's second revised winter operating protocol (2nd Revised WOP). On January 14, 2020, the Commission issued an Order requesting comments on the 2nd Revised WOP by February 10, 2020. On February 3, 2020, GMCW moved for an extension of the comment deadline to March 2, 2020 in order to give the parties additional time to run a potential trial test of new software and an opportunity to review trial parameters before submitting comments on the 2nd Revised WOP to the Commission. The Commission granted this motion on February 4, 2020.

The Department now moves to extend the comment deadline by an additional three weeks, to Monday, March 23, 2020. The parties are continuing to discuss implementation of the 2nd Revised WOP, including the potential for running and reviewing a trial test of the new software. The Department is authorized to represent that the parties (GMCW and Scott and Melodie McLane) support this request.
