**AMENDMENT TO CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC GOOD (“CPG”)
ISSUED PURSUANT TO 30 V.S.A. SECTION 248**

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) this day found and adjudged that an amendment to the CPG entered on May 31, 2011, in Case No. 7628 authorizing the construction and operation of up to a 63 MW wind electric generation facility (the “Project”) by Green Mountain Power Corporation (“CPG Holder”) on Lowell Mountain in Lowell, Vermont, in accordance with the evidence and plans submitted in this proceeding, will promote the general good of the State. Accordingly, the CPG entered on May 31, 2011, in Case No. 7628 is amended as follows:

1. Site preparation, construction, operation, maintenance, and decommissioning of the Project shall be in accordance with the plans and evidence submitted in Case No. 7628, and as superseded by the plans and evidence submitted in this proceeding. Any material deviation from these plans or a substantial change to the Project must be approved by the Commission. Failure to obtain advance approval from the Commission for a material deviation from the approved plans or a substantial change to the Project may result in the assessment of a penalty pursuant to 30 V.S.A. §§ 30 and 247.

2. The CPG Holder shall comply with the authorization under the Vermont Agency of Natural Resources Department of Environmental Conservation (“VT DEC”) Construction Stormwater General Permit (#3-9020) issued on July 17, 2020.

3. The CPG Holder shall follow appropriate Erosion Prevention and Sediment Control practices during the construction of the level spreader relocation project.

4. The CPG Holder shall comply with VT DEC Operational Stormwater Discharge Permit #6216-INDS.

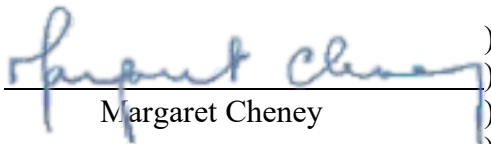
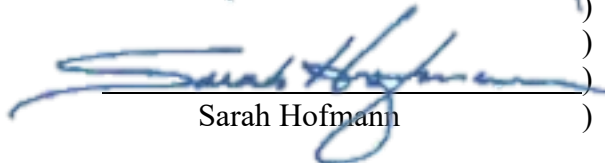
5. The CPG Holder shall develop a comprehensive non-native invasive species (“NNIS”) prevention, monitoring, and control plan and obtain written approval of the plan from ANR before conducting any vegetation clearing or earth-disturbing activities related to the relocation of the level spreaders at the Project site.

6. The CPG Holder shall file with the Commission the NNIS plan required by Condition 4, above, before conducting any vegetation clearing or earth-disturbing activities related to relocation of the level spreaders at the Project site.

7. This Amendment to Certificate of Public Good shall not be transferred without prior approval of the Commission.

The terms and conditions of the CPG entered on May 31, 2011, in Case No. 7628 shall remain in effect, except as modified herein.
