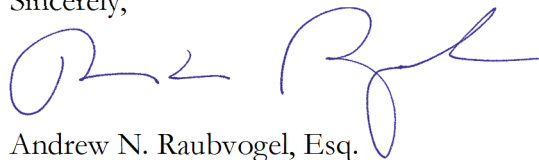

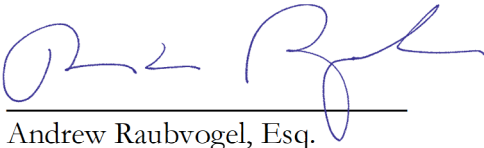
**Deerfield Wind, LLC’s Motion to Correct Clerical Error
in Commission Order of June 26, 2020**

Pursuant to Vermont Rule of Civil Procedure 60(a), CPG Holder Deerfield Wind, LLC (“Deerfield Wind”) hereby requests that the Commission correct a clerical error in its Order Regarding Fall 2020 Sound Monitoring, dated June 26, 2020.

On page 6, the Commission’s Order held, in part: “The Commission orders testing at Site B per its decision, below.” As reflected in the findings and conclusions throughout the Order,¹ the reference in the sentence should have been to testing at Site C (the Shea residence) and not to Site B. Therefore, the sentence should be corrected to read as follows: “The Commission orders testing at Site C per its decision, below.”

¹ See, e.g., the following excerpts from the Order: “In this order, we require an additional round of sound monitoring in the Fall of 2020 to determine whether further outside-to-inside noise reduction (“OINR”) testing at Mr. Tom Shea’s residence is required.” Order at 1. “The Commission concludes that the Fall 2020 sound monitoring should be conducted at Site C.” Id. at 6. “The Commission declines to order OINR testing at Site B.” Id. at 11. “[T]he Commission does not order additional testing at Site B...” Id. at 13.
