**ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENT TO DECOMMISSIONING FUND LETTER OF CREDIT**

On April 16, 2009, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) issued an order and certificate of public good (“CPG”) in this case approving, subject to certain conditions, the construction and operation of an electric generation facility by Deerfield Wind, LLC (“CPG Holder”).<sup>1</sup> The CPG included conditions requiring the CPG Holder to file for Commission review and approval a letter of credit.<sup>2</sup>

On March 31, 2022, Santander Bank, N.A. filed with the Commission an amendment to the previously approved letter of credit increasing the amount by \$300,219 to \$2,597,024.

Having reviewed the amendment to the letter of credit, we find that it complies with our requirements regarding letters of credit, and it is approved.

To ensure compliance with current Commission requirements, the CPG Holder is encouraged to consult the Commission’s website (<https://puc.vermont.gov/electric/letter-of-credit>) where up-to-date information about filing a letter of credit is posted, including a sample letter of credit and drawing certificate.

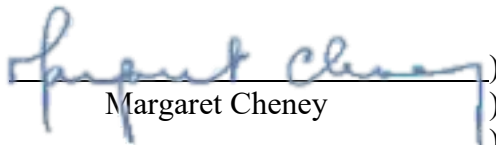
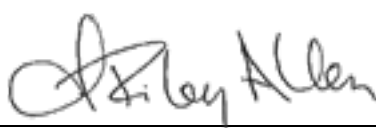

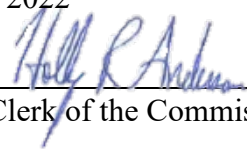
