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**DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE'S RESPONSE ON BURLINGTON
ELECTRIC DEPARTMENT'S REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL TIME**

On September 15, 2022, the City of Burlington Electric Department ("BED") filed a request for a two-week extension to file its proposed 2023 ("EEC") rates. Pursuant to the Public Utility Commission's ("PUC" or "Commission") Rule 5.306, an Energy Efficiency Utility is required to file its calculation of the Electric EEC rates on October 1st for the following year; BED requests the Commission's approval to file its calculation by October 17th. BED explains that the extension is necessitated by staffing difficulties. The Department of Public Service has reviewed BED's request and has no objections.
