ORDER RE: MOTION TO ADD CVPS

On April 5, 2012, Georgia Mountain Community Wind, LLC ("GMCW") and Central Vermont Public Service Corporation ("CVPS") filed a motion to amend GMCW's petition for a certificate of public good to add CVPS as a co-petitioner for the limited purpose of authorizing CVPS to own, construct, operate, and maintain portions of the transmission facilities associated with the wind generating facility. The motion includes a plan, identified as Attachment A, that identifies the facilities that would be owned, constructed, operated, and maintained by CVPS.

No party filed a response to the April 5 motion.

The Public Service Board ("Board") approved the final design plans for the project, including the transmission facilities identified in Attachment A, on December 9, 2011. The April 5 motion represents that GMCW and CVPS are not requesting any alteration of the facilities approved in the December 9 Order.

We grant the April 5 motion and add CVPS as a co-petitioner to this Docket for the limited purpose of authorizing CVPS to own, construct, operate, and maintain those portions of the transmission facilities, identified in Attachment A to the April 5 motion, associated with interconnection of the wind generation facility.
