ORDER RE MOTION TO APPEAR PRO HAC VICE

On May 9, 2012, the towns of Craftsbury and Albany (the "Towns") filed a Motion for Admission Pro Hac Vice, asking the Public Service Board ("Board") to approve the *pro hac vice* admission of Patrick J. Bernal, Esq., of Witten, Woolmington and Campbell, P.C., to appear before the Board on behalf of the Towns in this proceeding. The Towns represent that Attorney Bernal is a member in good standing of the bar in the State of New York and the following federal courts: the United States Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit and the United States District Court for the Districts of Vermont; Southern District of New York and Eastern District of New York. The Towns represent that Robert E. Woolmington, Esq., will serve as co-counsel of record in this Docket, and that Attorney Woolmington is admitted to practice in the State of Vermont.

The Towns request that the Board rule on this motion prior to May 22, 2012, to allow Attorney Bernal to assist with a deposition on that date. Because a ruling on this motion does not appear to be adverse to any party, the Board is issuing a ruling on the motion before the expiration of the standard 15-day response period. If any party objects to this Order, they may file a motion for reconsideration. Based on the Towns' representations in its motion, the Board hereby grants the motion and admits Patrick J. Bernal, Esq., *pro hac vice*.
