Re: Albany/Craftsbury June 20th motion for extension to file comments

Date: July 1, 2011

On June 10, 2011, the Petitioners in Docket 7628 filed with the Public Service Board ("Board") the second of a number of compliance filings required by the Board's Order of May 31, 2011 (the "Order"). The June 10, 2011, filing contained the draft Noise Monitoring Protocol required by Condition 41 of the Order. Pursuant to the Order, party comments on the draft Noise Monitoring Protocol were due on June 24, 2011.

On June 20, 2011, the Towns of Albany and Craftsbury (the "Towns") filed a motion asking that they be allowed until July 1, 2011, to file their comments on the draft Noise Monitoring Protocol. According to the Towns, unavoidable conflicts in the schedules of their attorney and their noise expert necessitated the request.

On June 24, 2011, the Clerk's Office issued a Memorandum in which the Board allowed the parties to file supplemental comments on Petitioners' first set of compliance filing materials¹ by July 1, 2011, and also extended the deadline for comments on the Petitioners' June 10, 2011, filing from June 24 to July 1, 2011. The Board based its decision on the large volume of materials that the Petitioners filed on June 6, 2011, and the fact that at the same time the parties had been preparing and responding to motions for reconsideration.

Based on the June 24, 2011, Memorandum, unless the Board hears otherwise from a party, the Board will assume that no further action is needed on the Towns' June 20, 2011 motion.
