UTILITY 2023 ENERGY EFFICIENCY CHARGE RATE FILINGS**

Pursuant to Public Utility Commission Rule 5.300, Efficiency Vermont, Vermont Gas Systems, Inc. and City of Burlington Electric Department filed calculations of their proposed 2023 Energy Efficiency Charge (“EEC”) Rates.¹ The Department of Public Service has reviewed all three energy efficiency utilities’ (“EEUs”) proposed rates, and confirms that it has no additional concerns, comments or objections at this time on the rate calculations submitted by the EEUs.
