ORDER OPENING COMPLIANCE CASE IN ePUC

On May 16, 2022, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) issued an order in Docket 7156, a legacy case that had been conducted in paper, announcing that it would be opening a new case in ePUC for the filing of all future compliance materials required by the certificate of public good (“CPG”) issued on August 8, 2007, in Docket 7156.¹

Today’s order opens that compliance case, Case No. 23-0597-LCOMP. Therefore, all future compliance filings required by the CPG issued in Docket 7156 and comments on them must be made in the new compliance case. Inquiries or information about alleged compliance problems must also be filed in that case. In the event of such filings, the Commission will determine whether a separate case needs to be opened to address any new discrete issues that may arise. Unless a party has elected to participate using paper copies,² all future filings shall be made and received through ePUC.

² As required by the Commission’s Standards and Procedures Applicable to Electronic Filings Using ePUC, a party who elects to participate using paper copies will receive paper copies of filings. However, that party will also be required to serve paper copies of any of its filings on all other parties, unless the other parties consent to receive service electronically (e.g. by email attachment).
