**ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENT TO DECOMMISSIONING FUND LETTER OF CREDIT**

On August 8, 2007, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) issued an order and certificate of public good (“CPG”) in Case No. 7156 approving, subject to certain conditions, the construction and operation of an electric generation facility (the “Project”) by UPC Vermont Wind, LLC (“CPG Holder”).<sup>1</sup> The CPG included conditions requiring the CPG Holder to file for Commission review and approval a letter of credit.<sup>2</sup>

On February 22, 2018, the Commission approved a replacement letter of credit and drawing certificate filed on February 10, 2018.

On January 24, 2023, the Bank of Nova Scotia filed with the Commission an amendment to the previously approved letter of credit increasing the amount by \$143,829 to \$1,879,359.

Having reviewed the amendment to the letter of credit, we find that it complies with our requirements regarding letters of credit, and it is approved.

For future filings, the CPG Holder is encouraged to consult the Commission’s website (<https://puc.vermont.gov/electric/letter-of-credit>) where information about filing a letter of credit is posted, including a sample letter of credit and drawing certificate.

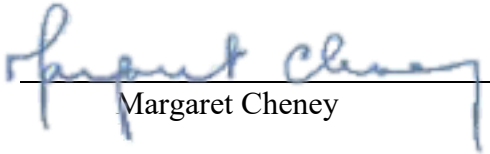
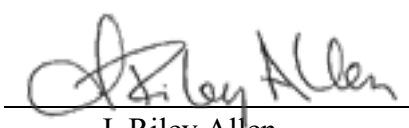

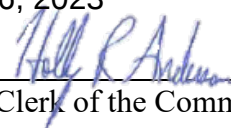
