ORDER REGARDING COMMENTS ON PETITION TO AMEND

On August 8, 2023, Deerfield Wind, LLC (“Deerfield Wind”) filed a petition to amend the certificate of public good (“CPG”) issued to it by the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) on April 16, 2009, and amended on July 17, 2009, in Docket No. 7250.

Specifically, Deerfield Wind seeks an amendment to Condition 19 of the CPG so its decommissioning reporting and funding obligations occur on a three-year cycle consistent with Commission Rule 5.904(B)(4), rather than on the annual basis currently required by the CPG.

To ensure a complete and accurate record and to allow for productive comments in this proceeding, I request that Deerfield Wind file a copy of exhibit DFLD-HGC-2 in this case within one week of the issuance of this order.

Individuals and entities that were parties to Docket No. 7250, the case in which the CPG was issued and amended, are being provided a copy of this order based on their interest in that case. All parties to Docket No. 7250 will automatically be made parties to this case and therefore do not need to file a new notice of appearance in ePUC for this case.

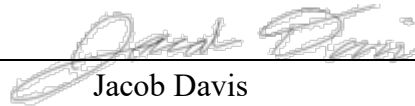
Comments and recommendations in response to Deerfield Wind’s petition shall be filed no later than close of business on September 27, 2023. Persons and entities with motions to intervene pending on that date may also file comments on the petition. If intervention motions are granted, the comments filed by those pending intervenors will be given consideration in reviewing the petition.

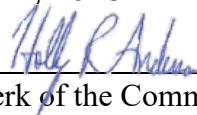
