ORDER REQUESTING COMMENT

On September 8, 2023, Vermont Wind, LLC (“Vermont Wind”) filed a petition to amend the certificate of public good (“CPG”) issued to it by the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) on August 8, 2007. Specifically, Vermont Wind seeks an amendment to Condition 32 of the CPG so its decommissioning fund inflation adjustment obligations occur on a three-year cycle consistent with Commission Rule 5.904(B)(4), rather than on the annual basis currently required by the CPG.

Individuals and entities that were parties to Docket No. 7156, the case in which the CPG was issued, are being provided a copy of this order based on their interest in that case. All parties to Docket No. 7156 will automatically be made parties to this case and therefore do not need to file a new notice of appearance in ePUC for this case. Comments and recommendations in response to Vermont Wind’s petition shall be filed no later than close of business on September 29, 2023. Persons and entities with motions to intervene pending on that date may also file comments on the petition. If intervention motions are granted, the comments filed by those pending intervenors will be given consideration in reviewing the petition.

This case is being conducted using the Commission’s online filing system, ePUC, and has been assigned Case No. 23-3088-PET. All filings shall be made using ePUC under that case number.

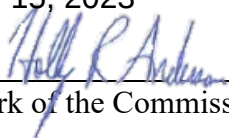
