ORDER APPROVING DECOMMISSIONING FUND LETTER OF CREDIT

On May 31, 2011, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) issued an order and certificate of public good (“CPG”) in Case No. 7628 approving, subject to certain conditions, the construction and operation of an electric generation facility (the “Project”) by Green Mountain Power Corporation (“CPG Holder”).¹ The CPG included conditions requiring the CPG Holder to file for Commission review and approval a letter of credit.²

On August 31, 2023, the Commission rejected the letter of credit filed on August 11, 2023, because it did not comply with the Commission’s requirements.

On September 6, 2023, the CPG Holder filed with the Commission a revised letter of credit and drawing certificate.

Having reviewed the revised letter of credit, we find that it complies with our requirements regarding letters of credit, and it is approved. The replacement letter of credit supplants the previous letter of credit, and the previous letter of credit is now terminated.

The CPG Holder is required to file an original paper version of the fully executed letter of credit with the Commission.

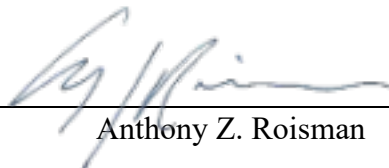
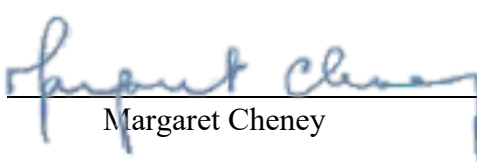

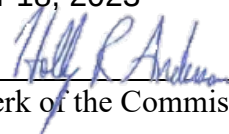
