ORDER CLOSING CASE

On August 8, 2007, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) issued a Certificate of Public Good (“CPG”) pursuant to 30 V.S.A. §§ 219a or 8010 and 248 to Vermont Wind, LLC (“Vermont Wind” or “Petitioner”), authorizing the construction and operation of a 40 MW wind generation facility in Sheffield, Vermont.

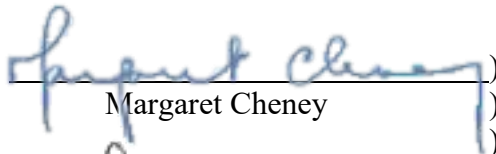
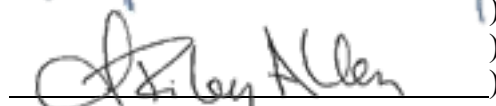
On September 8, 2023, the Petitioner filed a petition to amend the CPG. The petition was assigned Case No. 23-3088-PET.

On October 12, 2023, the Commission issued an order in Case No. 23-3088-PET amending the CPG. Therefore, this case, Case No. 23-0597-LCOMP, is closed.

All future compliance filings required by the CPG issued in Case No. 23-0597-LCOMP must be made in the compliance subcase of Case No. 23-3088-PET. Parties in this case will be made parties in Case No. 23-3088-PET for the purposes of receiving notices of future compliance filings and an opportunity to file comments on those filings.
