Amended Petition of Deerfield Wind, LLC, for a certificate of public good authorizing it to construct and operate a 15-turbine, 30 MW wind generation facility, and associated transmission and interconnection facilities, on approximately 80 acres in the Green Mountain National Forest, located in Searsburg and Readsboro, Vermont, with 7 turbines to be placed on the east side of Route 8 on the same ridgeline as the existing GMP Searsburg wind facility (Eastern Project Area), and 8 turbines along the ridgeline to the west of Route 8 in the northwesterly orientation (Western Project Area)

ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENT TO DECOMMISSIONING FUND LETTER OF CREDIT

On April 16, 2009, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) issued an order and certificate of public good (“CPG”) in this case approving, subject to certain conditions, the construction and operation of an electric generation facility (the “Project”) by Deerfield Wind, LLC (“CPG Holder”).¹ The CPG included conditions requiring the CPG Holder to file for Commission review and approval a letter of credit.²

On March 17, 2023, the Commission rejected the proposed amendment to the letter of credit filed by the CPG Holder on February 1, 2023.

On April 6, 2023, the CPG Holder filed a revised amendment to the letter of credit with the Commission.

Having reviewed the revised amendment to the letter of credit, we find that it complies with our requirements regarding letters of credit, and it is approved.

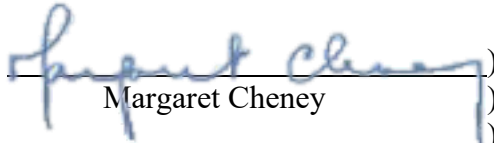
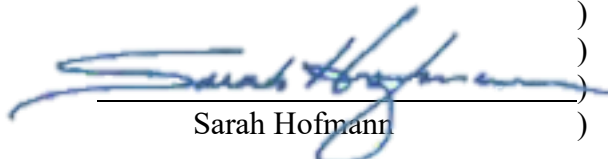

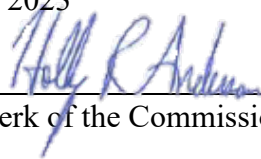
