Certificate of Public Good Municipal Notice Form Maaya Mead Town Clerk

General Instructions:

Pursuant to Act No. 174 of the 2016 Legislative Session, the holder of a certificate of public good ("CPG") or amendment to a CPG for an in-state generation facility with a capacity that is greater than 15 kilowatts must, within 45 days of issuance, record a notice of the CPG or amended CPG on the form prescribed by the Vermont Public Utility Commission ("Commission") in the land records of each municipality in which a facility subject to the CPG is located. The CPG holder must also submit proof of this recording to the Commission using ePUC, the Commission's online filing and case management system.¹ If you have any questions, contact the Clerk of the Public Utility Commission at (802) 828-2358 or puc.clerk@vermont.gov.
