Amended Petition of Deerfield Wind, LLC, for a certificate of public good authorizing it to construct and operate a 15-turbine, 30 MW wind generation facility, and associated transmission and interconnection facilities, on approximately 80 acres in the Green Mountain National Forest, located in Searsburg and Readsboro, Vermont, with 7 turbines to be placed on the east side of Route 8 on the same ridgeline as the existing GMP Searsburg wind facility (Eastern Project Area), and 8 turbines along the ridgeline to the west of Route 8 in the northwesterly orientation (Western Project Area)

ORDER CLOSING CASE

On August 8, 2023, Deerfield Wind, LLC (“Deerfield Wind”) filed a petition with the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) requesting an amendment to the certificate of public good (“CPG”) issued to Deerfield Wind by the Commission on April 16, 2009, and amended on July 17, 2009, in Docket No. 7250. That petition was assigned Case No. 23-2700-PET.

On December 6, 2023, the Commission issued an order in Case No. 23-2700-PET granting an amendment to Condition 19 of the CPG so that Deerfield Wind’s decommissioning reporting and funding obligations occur on a three-year cycle consistent with Commission Rule 5.904(B)(4), rather than on an annual basis as required under the original CPG (“Amended CPG”). In the same order, the Commission announced that all future compliance materials required by the Amended CPG must be made in the compliance subcase of Case No. 23-2700-PET, using ePUC.¹ Therefore, all future compliance filings required by the CPG issued and amended in Docket 7250 and comments on them must be made in the compliance subcase of Case No. 23-2700-PET. Inquiries or information about alleged compliance problems must also

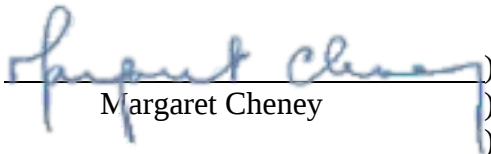

be filed in that case. In the event of such filings, the Commission will determine whether a separate case needs to be opened to address any new discrete issues that may arise.

Because all future compliance-related materials required by the CPG will be made in ePUC Case No. 23-2700-PET, Docket 7250 is closed.

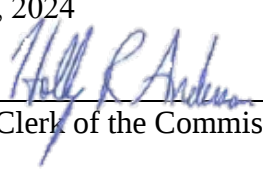
