**ORDER APPROVING REPLACEMENT DECOMMISSIONING FUND LETTER OF CREDIT**

On June 11, 2010, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) issued an order and certificate of public good (“CPG”) in Case No. 7508 approving, subject to certain conditions, the construction and operation of an electric generation facility (the “Project”) by Georgia Mountain Community Wind, LLC (“CPG Holder”).<sup>1</sup> The CPG included conditions requiring the CPG Holder to file for Commission review and approval a letter of credit.<sup>2</sup>

On September 11, 2024, the CPG Holder filed a replacement letter of credit with the Commission.

On September 19, 2024, the Commission issued an order rejecting the letter of credit.

On September 20, 2024, the CPG Holder filed a revised letter of credit and drawing certificate with the Commission as well as supporting documentation verifying that PNC Bank National Association is an A-rated financial institution.

Having reviewed the revised replacement letter of credit, we find that it complies with our requirements regarding letters of credit, and it is approved. The replacement letter of credit supplants the previous letter of credit, and the previous letter of credit is now terminated.

The CPG Holder is required to file an original paper version of the fully executed letter of credit with the Commission.

For future filings, the CPG Holder is encouraged to consult the Commission’s website (<https://puc.vermont.gov/electric/letter-of-credit>) where information about filing a letter of credit is posted, including a sample letter of credit and drawing certificate.

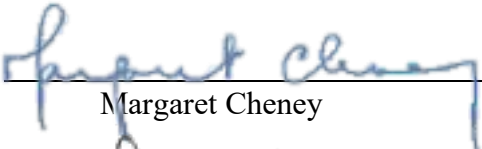
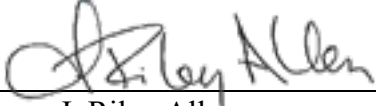

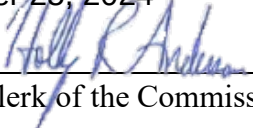
