ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENT TO DECOMMISSIONING FUND LETTER OF CREDIT

On June 11, 2010, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) issued an order and certificate of public good (“CPG”) in Case No. 7508 approving, subject to certain conditions, the construction and operation of an electric generation facility (the “Project”) by Georgia Mountain Community Wind, LLC (“CPG Holder”).¹ The CPG included conditions requiring the CPG Holder to file for Commission review and approval a letter of credit.²

On September 25, 2024, the Commission approved a letter of credit and drawing certificate filed on September 20, 2024.

On December 3, 2024, the CPG Holder filed an amendment to the previously approved letter of credit that modifies the first sentence to read as follows: “At the request of Georgia Mountain Community Wind, LLC (“Project Company”) and Pemaquid Manager LLC (the “Applicants”), PNC Bank National Association (the “Issuer”) hereby issues this irrevocable letter of credit. . . .”

Having reviewed the amendment to the letter of credit, we find that it complies with our requirements regarding letters of credit, and it is approved.

The CPG Holder is required to file an original paper version of the fully executed letter of credit with the Commission.

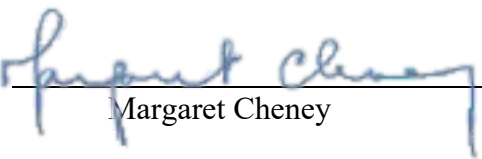
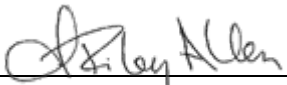

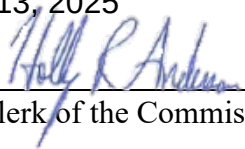
