ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENT TO DECOMMISSIONING FUND LETTER OF CREDIT

On May 31, 2011, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) issued an order and certificate of public good (“CPG”) in Case No. 7628 approving, subject to certain conditions, the construction and operation of an electric generation facility (the “Facility”) by Green Mountain Power Corporation (“CPG Holder”).^{1, 2} The CPG included conditions requiring the CPG Holder to file for Commission review and approval a letter of credit.³

On September 18, 2023, the Commission approved a letter of credit and drawing certificate filed on September 6, 2023.

On January 28, 2025, the CPG Holder filed an amendment to the previously approved letter of credit with TD Bank that increases the amount from \$9,003,433 to \$9,124,416 to adjust for inflation.

On April 17, 2025, Commission staff issued a request for information asking the CPG Holder to confirm that TD Bank continues to maintain its status as an A-rated financial institution.

On April 29, 2025, the CPG Holder filed documentation confirming that TD Bank is an A-rated financial institution.

Having reviewed the amendment to the letter of credit, we find that it complies with our requirements regarding letters of credit, and it is approved.

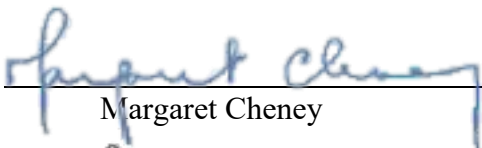
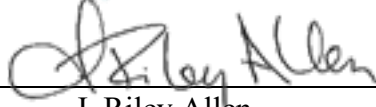
