ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

On May 31, 2011, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) issued an order and certificate of public good (“CPG”) in Docket No. 7628 authorizing the construction and operation by Green Mountain Power Corporation (“CPG Holder”) of an electric generation facility (“Project”). On August 3, 2020, the Commission issued an amendment to the CPG in Case No. 20-1951-PET.¹

The CPG Holder’s Commission-approved decommissioning plan requires the CPG Holder to report on and adjust its decommissioning fund balance each year by January 31. The decommissioning plan provides that the inflation adjustment will be calculated using the Producer Price Index (“PPI”) that is posted on the Department of Labor/Bureau of Labor Statistics’ website.²

On January 23, 2026, the CPG Holder filed a letter stating that as of that date, the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics had not yet released the PPI figure for December 2025. Therefore, the CPG Holder asks for an extension of time to file this inflation adjustment and update its letter of credit accordingly. Specifically, the CPG Holder asks for an extension of time until 15 days after the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics makes the December 2025 PPI figure publicly available.

Pursuant to Commission Rule 2.207(C), the Commission may extend a deadline if the request is made at least three days before the deadline and good cause is shown. The CPG Holder’s request is timely and we find that the CPG Holder has demonstrated good cause for the extension. Therefore, the request is granted. Because the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics

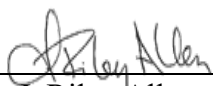

released the December PPI data on January 30, 2026,³ the CPG Holder must file its 2026 inflation adjustment no later than February 17, 2026.

SO ORDERED.

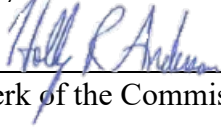
