ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENT TO DECOMMISSIONING FUND LETTER OF CREDIT

On May 31, 2011, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) issued an order and certificate of public good (“CPG”) in Case No. 7628 approving, subject to certain conditions, the construction and operation of an electric generation facility by Green Mountain Power Corporation (“CPG Holder”).^{1, 2} The CPG included conditions requiring the CPG Holder to file for Commission review and approval a letter of credit.³

On September 18, 2023, the Commission approved an initial letter of credit and drawing certificate filed on September 6, 2023.

On February 2, 2026, the Commission issued an order granting an extension of time to February 17, 2026, for the CPG Holder to file its 2026 inflation adjustment.

On February 11, 2026, the CPG Holder filed with the Commission an amendment to the previously approved letter of credit (Amendment #3 to Letter of Credit #20010326 from TD Bank) that increases the amount of the letter of credit to \$9,491,963 to account for inflation.

Having reviewed the amendment to the letter of credit, we find that it complies with our requirements regarding letters of credit, and it is approved.

The CPG Holder is required to file an original paper version of the fully executed amendment to the letter of credit with the Commission within 30 days of the date of this order.

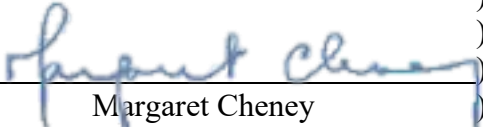
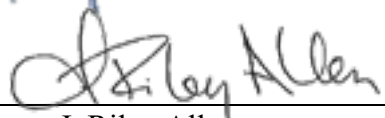

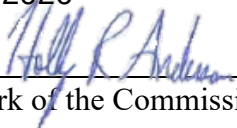
