**ORDER APPROVING AMENDMENT TO DECOMMISSIONING FUND LETTER OF CREDIT AND
FINDING CASE IN COMPLIANCE**

On June 11, 2010, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) issued an order and certificate of public good (“CPG”) in Docket No. 7508 approving, subject to certain conditions, the construction and operation of an electric generation facility by Georgia Mountain Community Wind, LLC (“CPG Holder”).¹

On June 9, 2025, the Commission issued an order informing the CPG Holder that it was out of compliance with its CPG and directing the CPG Holder to come into compliance within four weeks of that order. In the same order, the Commission proposed to amend the CPG to incorporate the Commission’s current standard decommissioning conditions.

On July 7, 2025, the CPG Holder filed a response to the Commission’s order.

On July 28, 2025, the Commission issued an order amending the CPG and accepting the CPG Holder’s calculation of the inflation adjustment to the decommissioning fund.²

On September 4, 2025, the CPG Holder filed with the Commission an amendment to the previously approved letter of credit (Amendment #2 to Letter of Credit #18140185-00-000 from PNC Bank, National Association) that increased the amount of the letter of credit to \$822,192.35.

² Consistent with Commission Rule 5.900, the amended CPG requires the CPG Holder to (1) adjust the value of the Project’s decommissioning fund for inflation every three years, (2) file a report with the Commission describing any adjustments and changes to the decommissioning fund in the previous three-year period, and (3) revise the facility’s letter of credit in conjunction with the report. *See* CPG at ¶¶ 33-35.

Having reviewed the amendment to the letter of credit, we find that it complies with our requirements regarding letters of credit, and it is approved.

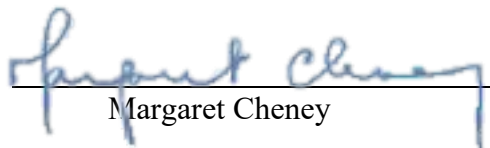
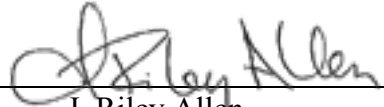
The Commission has received an original paper version of the fully executed amendment to the letter of credit.

The Commission now considers the CPG Holder to be up-to-date with respect to its compliance filing obligations. The CPG Holder's next decommissioning compliance filings are due February 28, 2028. If the CPG Holder does not file the required compliance by the deadline, the Commission may include this case on its overdue compliance filing webpage.

For future filings, the CPG Holder is encouraged to consult the Commission's website (<https://puc.vermont.gov/electric/letter-of-credit>) where information about filing decommissioning securities is posted, including a sample letter of credit and drawing certificate.

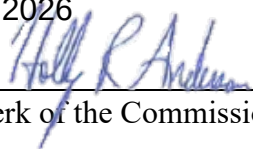
