*Status Report Regarding Aircraft Detection Lighting System Approval***

Dear Ms. Anderson:

This letter serves as a status report on compliance with Condition 34 of the Public Utility Commission's May 31, 2011 Order and Certificate of Public Good in the above-referenced case regarding an Aircraft Detection Lighting System (ADLS).

In our last update in November, Green Mountain Power (GMP) let the Commission know that we learned of a new ADLS System vendor to consider. GMP has worked to engage this vendor, and will continue to explore their product, but at this stage it appears their Doppler radar-based technology will not meet federal airspace coverage requirements. There does not appear to be any other vendors or new early-stage development technologies to consider. We continue to monitor changes in the marketplace to find a potential solution to deploy at the Kingdom Community Wind facility.
