ORDER RE: RICHARDSON WITHDRAWAL

On October 31, 2013, Daniel P. Richardson, Esq., filed a Notice of Withdrawal ("Notice") with the Public Service Board ("Board") indicating a withdrawal of his appearance as counsel for Daniel and Tina Fitzgerald, Jane Fitzgerald, George and Kenneth Wimble, Virginia and Kenneth Mongeon, Scott and Melodie McLane, and Matthew and Kimberly Parisi (the "Clients"). The Notice indicates that the withdrawal is at the request of the Clients.

Pursuant to PSB Rule 2.201(D), "An attorney who has appeared on behalf of a party may withdraw only upon permission of the Board." Accordingly, we are treating attorney Richardson's Notice as a motion to withdraw his appearance consistent with the requirements of PSB Rule 2.201(D). Additionally, since attorney Richardson is employed at the firm of Tarrant, Gillies, Merriman & Richardson, we are treating his Notice as a motion for the firm to withdraw its appearance on behalf of the Clients.

Given that the Notice was filed at the request of the Clients, we hereby grant the motion to withdraw representation on behalf of the Clients for both attorney Richardson and the firm of Tarrant, Gillies, Merriman & Richardson. The Clients are hereby reminded that they continue as individual parties to this proceeding subject to the responsibilities of *pro se* representation pursuant to PSB Rule 2.201(B).
