PROCEDURAL ORDER: REVISED SCHEDULE RE: VIOLATIONS PHASE

On October 1, 2012, the Public Service Board ("Board") issued a procedural order setting forth a schedule for addressing alleged and admitted violations of the June 11, 2010, Certificate of Public Good.

On October 2, 2012, the Department of Public Service ("Department") filed a letter requesting that the October 1 schedule be revised. The Department represents that its filing is on behalf of all parties.

We adopt the proposed revisions to the schedule, as set forth below.

October 19, 2012	Parties file statement of undisputed facts/issues, joint recommendations regarding Board penalties, list of unresolved issues, and Request for Hearing (if any)
October 29, 2012	Prefiled testimony filed by all parties (limited to facts/issues which remain in dispute)
November 5, 2012	Discovery requests due
November 13, 2012*	Discovery responses due
November 27, 2012	Supplemental/rebuttal testimony due
December 13, 2012 (starting at 9:30 a.m.)	Hearings with live surrebuttal

January 3, 2013	Post-hearing briefs due
January 10, 2013	Reply briefs due

* The Parties proposed November 12, 2012; however, this date is a Federal holiday, so the date has been changed to the next business day.
