SCHEDULING ORDER

On January 28, 1997, the Department of Public Service (the "Department") submitted a Motion to Revise the Schedule in this proceeding. The Department represented that the Motion was the "parties' joint motion." The parties propose changes to the schedule that will delay the expected final Board Order by about a month from the present schedule. The revised schedule also alters the manner in which the parties will file Position Papers, eliminating the simultaneous filing and replacing it with sequential submissions.
