ORDER RE: MODIFIED BRIEFING SCHEDULE FOR PHASE I

On September 6, 1995, Frontier Communications of New England, Inc. ("Frontier") filed a motion to extend the deadline for the filing of initial briefs in this docket from September 22nd to September 29th. Frontier also requested that the deadline for reply briefs be likewise extended (to October 13th). Frontier stated that it had "spoken with the representatives of most of the parties in this docket and all have indicated their consent to this request. . . ." Frontier Motion, 9/6/95, at 1.

One week later, New England Telephone and Telegraph Company ("NYNEX") filed a motion requesting that the deadline for initial and reply briefs be set for October 6th and 20th respectively. In support of its motion, NYNEX pointed out that certain scheduling conflicts arise under both the original schedule and that proposed by Frontier. NYNEX also stated that it had discussed this revised schedule with the majority of the parties and that none opposes it.

No party has filed a response opposing either motion. I grant NYNEX's motion to extend the briefing schedule. Initial briefs will be due on October 6, 1995, and reply briefs will be filed two weeks later, on October 20th.
