Re: Next Steps in Track C, Geotargeting

Date: December 14, 2010

On December 13, 2010, the Public Service Board ("Board") staff held the first workshop in the Geotargeting, or Track C, review process. Representatives from the Vermont Department of Public Service ("DPS"), the DPS's consultants, Central Vermont Public Service Corporation ("CVPS"), Green Mountain Power Corporation ("GMP"), Efficiency Vermont ("EVT"), and Vermont Public Power Supply Authority ("VPPSA") attended the workshop.

Workshop attendees discussed the Draft Geotargeting Evaluation Report ("Draft Report") filed by the DPS on December 10, 2010. At the workshop, Board staff revised the comment deadline on the Draft Report. Any comments on the Draft Report must be filed by December 22, 2010. The due date for the DPS to file the final Geotargeting Evaluation Report will remain January 7, 2011.

The scope of the Draft Report did not include an assessment of whether the geotargeting efforts have deferred, or are likely to defer, transmission and distribution ("T&D") upgrades. Therefore, utilities, and in particular CVPS and GMP, are asked to comment on this issue by January 13, 2011. The filings by CVPS and GMP should also address the steps that the utilities have taken to incorporate EVT's geotargeting activities into their planning efforts with respect to the geotargeted areas. Additionally, EVT should file any lessons learned with respect to the geotargeting activities to date by January 13, 2011.

Board staff will convene a second Track C workshop on January 18, 2011, to discuss next steps in geotargeting. Board staff request that participants submit topics for discussion by January 13, 2011.
