Dear Ms. Hudson,

Pursuant to Board's November 24, 2010 memorandum, VEIC was to file a revised Non-Resource Acquisition (NRA) proposal by January 7, 2011. Since that memorandum, VEIC and

the Department of Public Service have been sharing information with the goal of filing a proposal supported by both parties. However, given the complexity of the proposal and the competing demands of the other tracks of the Demand Resource Plan Proceeding, we have not achieved our goal. VEIC believes that an extension to January 31, 2011 for filing an updated VEIC NRA proposal will allow sufficient time to complete the work of the NRA track. We are informed that the Department supports this request and that they will also be requesting an extension to January 31st for the submission of their evaluation plan and budgets. One of VEIC's NRA initiatives involves Forward Capacity Market evaluation activities. The proposed extension will allow VEIC and the Department to better plan and allocate costs for those activities. We support that Department's extension request.

In the Board's memorandum, several areas of the proposals were identified that would require additional information. VEIC is mindful of those areas and will include such information in its updated filing. Thank you for the Board's consideration of our extension request.
