E-mail List for EEU-2010-06 (Demand Resources Plan Proceeding) – As stated in the email below, the Department of Public Service (“DPS”), Vermont Energy Investment Corporation (“VEIC”) and the City of Burlington Electric Department (“BED”) have jointly requested an extension of the schedule in Track A (regarding electric energy efficiency targets and budgets) of at least 2 weeks. According to the DPS, Central Vermont Public Service, Green Mountain Power Corporation, the Conservation Law Foundation, VELCO, and IBM have all indicated that they have no objections to this request.

The DPS circulated the request to the entire EEU E-mail Service list. The Vermont Public Power Supply Association responded via e-mail that it also has no objection to the request. The Board did not receive any other comments on the requested extension.

As noted in the DPS’s email, the original schedule for this proceeding was established to enable the results of the DRP to be incorporated into VELCO’s long-range transmission plan. VELCO has indicated that the requested extension will not adversely affect its planning activities.

Therefore, the requested extension is granted, and the January 27, 2011, workshop is cancelled. The DPS shall file a revised proposed schedule for Track A by January 21, 2011.

Subject: RE: EEU-2010-06 -- DRP

To the Public Service Board and Demand Resource Plan Proceeding Stakeholders:

The Department of Public Service, jointly with Vermont Energy Investment Corporation and Burlington Electric Department, request an extension of the schedule for “Track A” regarding electric energy efficiency budgets and targets, of at least two weeks. The Department and the EEU’s have been diligently working to meet the aggressive schedule, however given the multiple tracks and heavy workload the fast approaching deadlines in Track A do not appear to be achievable with fully vetted filings.

In the short term, this proposal would extend the filing deadline for stakeholder’s potential studies (currently January 19) and require postponement of the workshop scheduled for January 27th. In the longer term, it is likely that other currently scheduled deadlines and workshops in “Track A” will also be affected. The Department proposes to submit a proposed revised schedule by the end of this week.

The Department notes that the aggressive schedule currently in place was, in part, due to the timing of incorporating results of the DRP into the VELCO long range transmission plan. VELCO has indicated to the Department that the proposed breadth of this scope of this change of schedule will not adversely affect its planning activities.

Central Vermont Public Service, Green Mountain Power, Conservation Law Foundation, VELCO, and IBM have all indicated to the Department that they have no objections to this request.
