Re: Next Steps in Track C, Geotargeting

Date: April 27, 2011

On February 1, 2011, the Public Service Board ("Board") staff conducted a workshop in the Geotargeting, or Track C, review process. On March 18, 2011, the Board received comments in response to a Board staff memorandum from the following participants: the Vermont Department of Public Service ("DPS"), Central Vermont Public Service Corporation ("CVPS"), Green Mountain Power Corporation ("GMP") and Vermont Public Power Supply Authority ("VPPSA"). In its response, the DPS suggested that another workshop be held to discuss participants' comments, and that the DPS would seek input from Vermont System Planning Committee ("VSPC") on geotargeting prior to any subsequent geotargeting workshop.

Board staff will convene a workshop regarding geotargeting on **May 10, 2011, at 1:30 P.M.**, in the Board's Third Floor Hearing Room, People's United Bank Building (f/k/a Chittenden Bank Building), 112 State Street, Montpelier, Vermont. The purpose of the workshop will be to discuss the comments filed on March 18, and to work toward resolution of certain threshold issues, namely whether geotargeting should continue, the involvement of the VSPC in the geotargeting planning process, and the appropriate funding mechanism for geotargeting, if the program is to continue. In preparation for this workshop, Board staff requests that the DPS consult with VSPC, as posited in the DPS's March 18 filing. Workshop participants will be encouraged to comment on the appropriate next steps in the geotargeting review process.
