PROCEDURAL ORDER RE: SCHEDULE AMENDMENT

On August 5, 2016, the Vermont Public Utility Commission¹ (“Commission”) issued an Order establishing a schedule for this proceeding and designating me as lead Commission staff member authorized to, among other things, make scheduling decisions as necessary. On February 9, 2017, and March 24, 2017, I issued Orders amending the schedule following proposed schedule modifications filed by the Vermont Department of Public Service (“Department”).

On June 2, 2017, the Department, Vermont Energy Investment Corporation, the City of Burlington Electric Department (“BED”), and Vermont Gas Systems, Inc., jointly proposed a further schedule modification.

No comments on the proposal have been filed.

I hereby modify the remaining schedule in this proceeding consistent with the joint proposal, as follows.


7/28/17	Deadline for energy efficiency utilities (“EEUs”) to file final resource-acquisition scenario model results, quantifiable performance indicator (“QPI”) targets, and development and support services (“DSS”) plans and budget proposals. Deadline for the Department to file its evaluation plans and budget proposal. Deadline for recommendations for Fiscal Agent, EEU fund audit, triennial audit, thermal energy and process fuels (“TEPF”) clearinghouse, and TEPF PACE budget proposals.
7/31/17	Deadline for BED to file proposal for use of TEPF funds.

¹ Pursuant to Section 9 of Act 53 of the 2017 legislative session, the Vermont Public Service Board’s name was changed to the Vermont Public Utility Commission, effective July 1, 2017. For clarity, activities of the Vermont Public Service Board that occurred before the name change will be referred to in Commission documents as activities of the Commission unless that would be confusing in the specific context.

8/1/17	Workshop regarding materials filed on or before 7/28/17 as well as BED proposal for use of TEPF funds.
8/15/17	Deadline for comments following workshop.
9/5/17	Target date for Commission order on each EEU's DSS plans and budgets, BED proposal re: TEPF funds, any QPI definitions, QPI targets, including super-stretch targets, Department evaluation plan and budget, Fiscal Agent, EEU fund audit, triennial audit, TEPF clearinghouse, and TEPF PACE budget proposals.
9/15/17	Deadline for: (1) EEU compensation proposals, including total compensation amount and rate, operations fee and performance incentive rates, and scaling of earnings associated with the performance incentive; and (2) final rate and bill impact analysis.
9/21/17	Workshop regarding EEU compensation proposals and final rate and bill impact analysis.
10/6/17	Deadline for comments following workshop.
10/27/17	Target date for Commission order establishing total EEU program budgets.
11/01/17	Deadline for EEUs to file their 2018-2020 Triennial Plans.
