PROCEDURAL ORDER RE EVIDENTIARY HEARING NOT CANCELLED

On August 30, 2017, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) scheduled an evidentiary hearing in this case for September 12, 2017, at 2:30 P.M. On September 7, 2017, Travis Belisle (“Respondent”) filed notice with the Commission that he was waiving his right to that hearing and requested that it be cancelled. Respondent represented that the Vermont Department of Public Service (“Department”) and the Vermont Agency of Natural Resources did not object to the cancellation.

In response to the Respondent’s request, on September 8, 2017, I canceled the September 12, 2017, evidentiary hearing conditioned on the admission into evidence of all the testimony and exhibits previously filed in this investigation, specifically stating that if the Respondent objects to the admission of any of that evidence, an evidentiary hearing would be required to address any such objection.


The Respondent replied on September 8 by objecting to the admissibility of the testimony filed by the Department in this proceeding. Also on September 8, Christine and Dustin Lang objected to the cancellation of the evidentiary hearing.

On September 11, 2017, the Department filed a response to the Respondent’s objection recommending that the evidentiary hearing go forward as scheduled because of the Respondent’s objection.

Having failed to meet the condition for the cancellation of the evidentiary hearing, the hearing will proceed as scheduled at 2:30 P.M. on Tuesday, September 12, 2017, at the Susan M. Hudson Hearing Room, Third Floor, People’s United Bank Building, 112 State Street, Montpelier, VT 05620.
