ORDER OPENING INVESTIGATION AND NOTICE OF PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On April 13, 2018, Green Mountain Power Corporation (“GMP” or the “Company”) filed revised tariffs with the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) reflecting a 5.45% increase in its rates, to be fully offset by a bill credit for several months. The effective date of the tariff changes is identified as January 1, 2019.

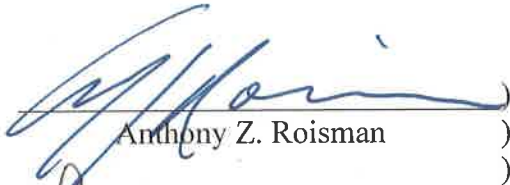
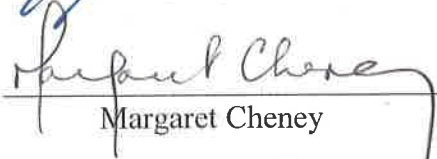
The Vermont Department of Public Service (the “Department”) was notified of this tariff filing via the Commission’s electronic case management system, ePUC, at the time of the Company’s filing. Pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 225, the Department shall investigate the justness and reasonableness of a proposed change to a rate schedule immediately upon receipt of notice of the change. On May 2, 2018, the Department recommended that the Commission suspend the proposed rate increase and open an investigation into GMP’s tariff filing.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the tariff filing submitted by GMP on April 13, 2018, is hereby suspended and shall not become effective until final determination of the proceedings hereby instituted. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Commission will investigate the Company’s proposed changes to determine whether or not such changes are just and reasonable.

The Commission will conduct a prehearing conference pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 10 in this proceeding, which will commence at 1:30 P.M., on Thursday, May 24, 2018, in the Susan M. Hudson Hearing Room, Third Floor, People’s United Bank Building, 112 State Street, Montpelier, Vermont.
