MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER

Pursuant to Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) Rule 2.214 and Rule 26(C) of the Vermont Rules of Civil Procedure (“V.R.C.P.”), Petitioner Green Mountain Power (“GMP”) respectfully requests that the Commission issue a Protective Order approving the attached Protective Agreement, dated May 14, 2018, between GMP and the Vermont Department of Public Service (“Department”). GMP and the Department have agreed to the terms of the Protective Agreement, including Schedule IV thereto, which represents a Proposed Protective Order. The Protective Agreement is needed to protect sensitive or confidential information that is designated as Critical Energy Infrastructure Information (“CEII”). The attached forms of Protective Agreement and Proposed Order have been approved by the Commission in other proceedings to facilitate the provision of information while preserving confidentiality.
