ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO INTERVENE

On May 4, 2018, GlobalFoundries U.S. 2 LLC (“GlobalFoundries”) filed a motion to intervene in this proceeding. GlobalFoundries states that it is a business electricity customer in Vermont. GlobalFoundries contends that it has a direct interest in ensuring that rates and reliability in Vermont are not affected adversely by the proposals advanced in this proceeding, and that it has substantial interests at issue in this proceeding. GlobalFoundries further asserts that it has substantial interests in this proceeding that are not adequately represented by any other participant and that there are no alternative means by which its interests can be protected. GlobalFoundries states that its intervention in this proceeding will not unduly delay the proceeding or prejudice the interests of existing parties or the public

On May 11 and 17, 2018, respectively, Green Mountain Power Corporation (“GMP”) and the Vermont Department of Public Service (“Department”) filed letters stating that they did not oppose the participation of GlobalFoundries in this proceeding.

Based upon our review of GlobalFoundries’ motion and the responses of GMP and the Department, the Vermont Public Utility Commission grants GlobalFoundries’ motion to intervene pursuant to Commission Rule 2.209(B).
