PREHEARING CONFERENCE ORDER

This case involves an investigation into a tariff filing by Green Mountain Power Corporation requesting a 5.45% increase in its base rates effective with bills rendered January 1, 2019, to be fully offset by bill credits through September 30, 2019.

On May 24, 2018, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (the “Commission”) held a prehearing conference in this matter. Appearances were entered by Daniel C. Burke, Esq., for the Vermont Department of Public Service; Geoffrey Hand, Esq., and Victoria M. Westgate, Esq., of Dunkiel Saunders Elliot Raubvogel & Hand, PLLC, on behalf of Green Mountain Power Corporation; and Shapleigh Smith, Jr., of Dinse, Knapp & McAndrew, P.C., on behalf of GlobalFoundries U.S. 2 LLC.

At the prehearing conference, the parties developed the following proposed procedural schedule, which is hereby adopted with minor modifications.

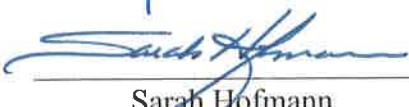

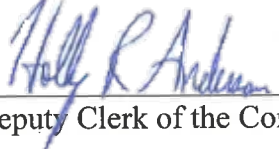
