PROCEDURAL ORDER AND NOTICE OF PREHEARING CONFERENCE

This case involves a petition filed by Green Mountain Power Corporation (“GMP”) for approval of a multi-year regulation plan pursuant to 30 V.S.A § 209, 218, and 218d. In past cases, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) has first held a prehearing conference, followed by public hearings and a deadline for intervention motions. To ensure that all intervenors are present at the prehearing conference, the Commission will conduct the public hearings and require intervention motions to be filed prior to the prehearing conference. Accordingly, the Commission hereby adopts the following schedule.





Deadline for motions to intervene	August 2, 2018
Deadline for responses to motions to intervene	3 days after motion is filed
Prehearing conference	August 3, 2018
Workshop	August 3, 2018 after prehearing conference

All public hearings will be preceded by a presentation by GMP describing its proposed regulation plan, beginning at 6:30 PM. The public hearings will commence at 7:00 PM. Intervenors are encouraged to file their motions to intervene as soon as possible.

The prehearing conference will commence at 9:30 AM and will be held in the Commission's hearing room on the 3rd floor of 112 State Street in Montpelier. Any pending intervenor should attend the prehearing conference even if the Commission has not yet ruled on their intervention request. The Commission has scheduled a workshop to review GMP's rate request on August 3, 2018, immediately following the prehearing conference. The public is welcome to attend the workshop.
